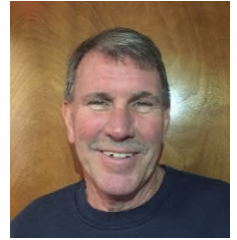

I would like to thank all of our committee and sub-committee members for taking on these vital roles for the success of IBEW Local 266.

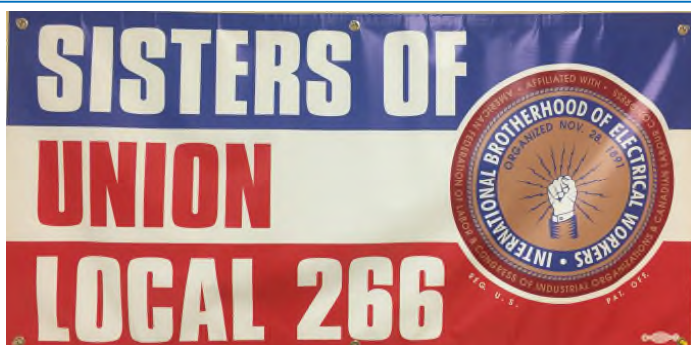

**I.B.E.W. Local 266 Proposed Bylaws Change**  
**Article IX**  
**Assessments - Admission Fees – Dues**  
**January 7, 2020**

**Official Notice**

**Valley / CGS Members:**

At the January 7, 2020 Valley / CGS Regular Meeting a standing bylaw change proposal was read. See below for the proposal.

In accordance with Article XV, Section 2(c) of the Local Union 266 Bylaws, this shall serve as your 20 day notice that at the Valley / CGS Regular Meeting on **Tuesday, February 4, 2020 at 5:30pm**, a second reading, discussion and a vote will be taken by secret ballot.

**Valley Shifter's:**

At the January 8, 2020 Valley Shifter's Meeting a standing bylaw change proposal was read. See below for the proposal.

In accordance with Article XV, Section 2(c) of the Local Union 266 Bylaws, this shall serve as your 20 day notice that at the Valley Shifter's Meeting on **Tuesday, February 4, 2020 at 11:00am**, a second reading, discussion and a vote will be taken by secret ballot. This meeting is being rescheduled from its normal date for voting purposes.

**Current Article IX Sec. 6 (a)**

Sec. 6. The monthly dues shall be:

- (a) "A" and "BA" members in all classifications shall pay an amount equivalent to 1.2% of their monthly base wages.
- (b) Applicable International payments and all assessments to be paid in addition to the above dues.
- (c) Members who are not covered by Agreement shall pay \$15.00 per month, plus the International payments provided for in (b) above.

**New Article IX Sec. 6 (a)**

Sec. 6. The monthly dues shall be:

- (a) "A" and "BA" members in all classifications shall pay an amount equivalent to 1.2% of their monthly base wages when General Fund Accounts total equal four million dollars (\$4,000,000) or lower, 1.1% when General Fund Accounts are between four million dollars (\$4,000,000) and five million dollars (5,000,000), and 1.0% when General Fund Accounts total above five million dollars (5,000,000).
- (b) Applicable International payments and all assessments to be paid in addition to the above dues.
- (c) Members who are not covered by Agreement shall pay \$15.00 per month, plus the International payments provided for in (b) above
